

A HARMONIOUS COMBINATION

A delicate jade green is supported by a front with vertical grooves in angora grey. Depending on the incidence of light, the 3D look enchants with a fascinating interplay of light and shadow. The handle-less appearance reinforces the generous overall impression. Integrated shelves in the same color as the front and an atmospheric lighting as well as wall shelves give the kitchen that certain something. A continuous wall unit lighting provides a uniform illumination of the work surface.

FOCUSSING ON ORGANIC SHAPES
