FEELS LIKE YOU: Kitchen planning that starts with people

From 19 to 25 September 2026, pronorm will present its latest innovations at its exhibition centre in Vlotho as part of KM Küchenmeile. Under the motto “feels like you”, the kitchen furniture manufacturer places individuality at the centre. The kitchen is consistently conceived around the people who use it: their habits, their everyday lives and their personal style.

The guiding question “How do you want to live?” continues the idea behind last year’s in-house exhibition. It forms the starting point for designs that extend beyond the kitchen itself. Kitchen, living space, dressing room and utility room are understood as connected areas of life. Consistent colours, materials and design elements create links between them, while each area can still be planned individually according to its purpose.

Individuality through greater freedom of combination

One focus of the 2026 in-house exhibition is greater colour continuity across several ranges and product lines. Fronts, materials and colours can therefore be combined even more freely. Different areas can be visually connected or deliberately distinguished from one another.

New fronts and surfaces broaden this spectrum. Calm beige and grey tones create an understated base, while structured fronts and different tactile finishes add depth to the space. Rounded end panels introduce softer lines into the design. The range is also complemented by a new glass-framed door, giving display cabinets a light, homely character and providing a setting for favourite personal pieces.

This creates greater design freedom without sacrificing clarity in planning. Different room sizes, living situations and personal styles can be realised individually while maintaining confidence in the design.

New functions for everyday life

Alongside colours and materials, pronorm is presenting new functional solutions in Vlotho designed around everyday needs. These include a new pantry cabinet, a swing-out shelf and a cabinet solution for the Quooker.

The new features offer further possibilities for adapting storage, workflows and technical equipment to individual requirements. Function is integrated naturally into the design and remains part of a calm, consistent overall appearance.

More possibilities for specialist retailers

The greater variety of combinations also gives kitchen specialists additional possibilities in consultation and planning. Customer requirements can be addressed in greater detail, while colours, fronts, materials and functions can be combined more freely.

Close dialogue with retail partners plays an important role. Experience gained through consultation and planning feeds into product development and provides impulses for solutions that reflect the requirements of retail partners and their customers. In this way, pronorm combines planning confidence with maximum individuality.

"feels like you" stands for spaces that reflect personal ideas and fit naturally into individual ways of living.

Desert beige and oak barrique bring soft, nostalgic tones into the present. Rounded end panels in organic glass create a soft, organic silhouette. The **Y-line** handle profile in bronze adds a fine, connecting line and a touch of elegance. At the centre, the display cabinet with its bronze-coloured aluminium glass frame – a stage for the things you love. The PLUS carcass height provides a comfortable working height and makes everyday life easier. This creates a kitchen in which your own story continues. For those who know exactly how they want to live.

CONFIDENT AND EXPRESSIVE.

The combination of buffalo ruby and Sherwood dark brown gives this kitchen a rich, earthy tone. Buffalo ruby makes its presence felt through more than colour alone: its finely textured surface creates a distinctive tactile quality and feels almost like real leather. Open shelves and interior drawer lighting add accents, while the black C-profile of the **X-line** maintains the clean line. A kitchen for design lovers who see colour not as a trend but as an expression of their own style.

CHARACTER WITH HIGH STANDARDS.

Genuine walnut veneer runs across the fronts as if made from a single piece – lively and naturally grown. The grain flows seamlessly across several fronts, creating a harmonious, continuous look. Deep petrol and dark brass complete the composition: a kitchen that has nothing to prove. Even the softly rounded support panels are made from the same veneer – allowing the kitchen to flow gently into the living space and become the heart of the home.

MINIMALIST. COMPLETELY ITSELF.

Everything has its place, nothing demands attention. Matt fronts in wool white and the wood effect of ash light create a calm canvas – against which favourite pieces can truly make their mark. The view remains clear for what matters: the clean line, the fine material, the one deliberate accent. Rounded, lacquered end panels create a softer appearance, fully in keeping with today's design language. The worktop in wool white granite provides a calm, refined base. The almost handleless design keeps everything tidy and clear. The kitchen feels functional, visually light and refined.

THE QUIET HERO OF THE HOME.

A workspace that makes concentration easy: gloss arctic white reflects the light and makes even compact floor plans appear open and bright. The worktop in Nizza sand creates a calm contrast, while the niche system keeps small items to hand and the surfaces clear. A design that deliberately steps back – allowing order, light and concentration to take centre stage. Well-planned pull-outs, clear laundry sorting and generous storage keep order where many things come together every day. The bronze end-panel trim and the handle in pebble grey in the utility room add subtle accents and show that function and aesthetics have been considered together down to the last detail. The fine linen look of natural linen turns a functional room into a place you enjoy entering – the work disappears where it belongs, leaving calm for everything else.
